Today, at a hotel in London, three women in their nineties received a standing ovation for their wartime work at Bletchley Park.

Bletchley Park Veterans Betty Webb, Ruth Bourne and Pat Davies represented all of their wartime colleagues at the Women of the Year awards.

At its peak in 1944, almost 9,000 people worked at Bletchley Park, 75% of whom were women.

Betty worked at Bletchley Park on German and later Japanese messages. Ruth was a Bombe Operator helping to find the settings of Enigma machines. Whilst Pat worked in the Y Service, intercepting encrypted messages.
